

## Boost for virtual biz

AN Irish virtual reality tech firm is aiming for global growth after floating on the stockmarket.

Waterford-based VR Education yesterday raised €6.75million when it offered its shares for the first time on the Irish Stock Exchange.

Chief exec David Whelan revealed the move, which values the company at €21.6million, would help “raise international capital to scale-up our business”.

He added the firm, which counts Oxford University and the BBC as clients, will use its new funds to make its Edge platform the “go-to simulated training choice globally”.
